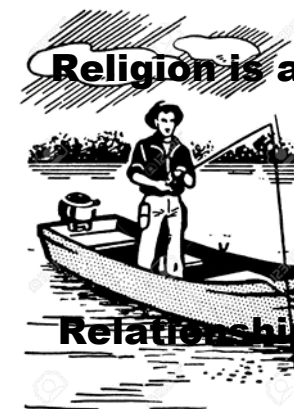
On Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> September there will be a **Quiet Day** at Hilfield Friary. Further details in due course – but book the date.
