For those who are unaware I quote: "Dorset Historic Churches Trust provides funds to help parishes keep their churches waterproof, warm and available for worship and wider public use.....Most of the Trust's income comes from the sponsored Ride and Stride event. In 2017, over £86,000 in sponsorship was raised by hundreds of participants of all ages and abilities. 50% of all money pledged was returned by the Trust to the Churches nominated by the riders and striders, so everyone benefited...."
